

SEN Disagreement Resolution Service East Midlands



The Together Trust provides Disagreement Resolution Services (DRS) to Local Authorities in the East Midlands. Disagreement resolution (or mediation) is voluntary, independent, confidential and a positive way of solving problems. It aims to improve communication and assist negotiation.

Disagreements involving special educational needs vary depending on each individual. Mediation can assist with disputes over whether or not an assessment should be carried out, what special needs the child or young person has, how best to meet these needs, and which school they should attend.

Mediation considers what is best for the child. It ensures that key people take part in the resolution process and gives everyone a chance to speak and listen. Mediators are neutral and don't take sides, enabling them to focus on protecting relationships.

Key Facts

- Mediation is a positive way of resolving disagreements. Everyone is involved in making decisions
- Mediation is voluntary. Everyone agrees to mediation, and can stop taking part at any time
- Mediators are independent and neutral. They do not take sides
- It is confidential. The record of discussion is agreed at the meeting and everyone receives a copy

Provision of SEN Disagreement Resolution Services

Referrals are made directly to the service by parents/carers, schools or by Local Authorities. The service is provided free of charge to parents/carers and does not affect the ability to take a case to the SEN Tribunal or interfere with other legal rights.
