



What can I do to prepare for a review of my child's Individual Education Plan (IEP)?

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- Ask school for a copy of the IEP if you don't have one.
 - Talk to your child about their progress and what they would like to achieve.
- Note the points that you are concerned about. For example:
 - Is your child achieving their targets?
 - Are your child's test results lower than those of most other children of the same age?
 - Is your child having difficulty with one particular subject?
 - Have teachers commented about your child's concentration, organisational difficulties or social difficulties?

At the Meeting

- You may wish to take a friend or parental supporter
- Ask the questions that you have prepared and ask people to explain anything that you don't understand.
- Ask for ideas about how you can help your child at home.
- Take notes of all the main points made at the meeting and any agreed actions.
- You should come away with an understanding of what you and your child's teachers will do to help your child succeed.
