## What are Social Scripts?

Social Scripts are based on Social Stories™, developed by Carol Gray. They provide a format in which to teach people with an ASD about social expectations in the world around them. People with an ASD find subtle social cues impossible to read, and so they need lots of input to function in the social realm.

## How can they help?

In the context of the home, Social Scripts can help children and young people to manage more successfully the difficulties they experience in social situations.

They can also help prepare for a new experience of a change in routine. A Social Script might give other people's perspectives and give information of a "good thing to do" in different situations.

As helpful as Social Stories™ can be, many parents (and professionals!) find actually making the stories a very daunting process.

## The CD Resource

This resource has been compiled by the Northamptonshire Children and Young People's Service Autism Spectrum Team alongside Autism Concern and F.A.C.T.

It is meant to help answer the question "where do I start?" and give practical tips on writing a social story.

Sometimes it helps to see a story that is already written. All scripts can be altered or adapted to meet the needs of the young person.

The Autism Spectrum Team have made, developed and used many Social Scripts™ with students in our consultative work. We have endeavoured to collect a wide range of stories that we have actually used and some written by parents that may be of benefit to you in inspiring your own Social Scripts.

The CD resource contains scripts written mostly in Word or PowerPoint format.
